- 2. This proposal does not include painting or decorating in the process of work performed unless otherwise specified. All wood replacements will be primed. Items recommended will be replaced as close as possible to original but are not guaranteed to match.
- 3. During the course of/or after opening walls or any previously concealed areas, should any further damage or infestation be found, a supplementary report will be issued. Any work completed in these areas would be at Owner's direction and additional expense.
- 4. During the process of treatment or replacement it may be necessary to drill holes through ceramic tiles or other floor covering and/or walls; these holes will then be sealed. We will exercise due care but assume no responsibility for cracks. Chipping or damage to floor/wall coverings. We do not re-lay carpeting. Nor reinstall wall coverings. During treatment the possibility of chemical trespass exists. It is further agreed that the owner/agent holds this firm harmless for any damage caused by said trespass or seepage.
- 5. We assume no responsibility for damage to any plumbing. Gas or Electrical lines etc..., in the process of pressure treatment of concrete slab/concealed wall areas or re- placement of concrete or structural timber.
- 6. When a fumigation is recommended we will exercise all due care but assume no responsibility for damage to Shrubbery, Trees, Plants, 1V Antennas or Roofs. A FUMIGATION NOTICE will be left with, or mailed to the Owner of this property, or his designated Agent. Occupant must comply with instructions contained in Fumigation Notice and Fumigation instruction sheet. During fumigation and aeration the possibility of burglary exists as it does any time you leave your home. Therefore, we recommend that you take any and all steps that you feel necessary to prevent any damage to your properly. We also recommend that you contact your insurance agent and verify that you have insurance coverage to protect against any loss damage or vandalism to your property. The company does not provide any onsite security except as required by state or local ordinance and does not assume any responsibility for care and custody of the property in case of vandalism, breaking and entering.
- 7. Your termite report and clearance will cover any EXISTING infestation or infection only, which is outlined in the report. If Owner of property desires coverage of any new infestation it would be advisable to obtain an Annual Control Service Policy, which would cover any new infestation for the coming year.
- 8. The total amount of this contract is due and payable upon completion of work unless otherwise specified. A finance charge computed at a monthly rate of 2.0% of the unpaid balance (annual percentage rate of 24%) will be added to all accounts past due 30 days or more in addition to a filing/administrative fee of \$125.00 and late fee of \$100.00.
- 9. If work contained in this proposal is for escrow purposes, it is agreed this firm is hereby designated/appointed by buyer/seller of property to be authorized to receive any and all information from escrow holder for purposes of assuring that full and complete payment is/will be made for work performed. Buyer/seller further authorize escrow holder to release and information and funds they hold on behalf of buyer/seller including but not limited to earnest money deposited to Farmer Termite Control upon written demand by Farmer Termite Control. Buyer/seller further instruct escrow holder not to close escrow, should escrow holder receive any instruction either written or verbal, unilateral or bilateral from parties/agents to escrow to withhold or close without paying Farmer Termite for invoices forwarded to escrow holder for work completed, without written approval from Farmer Termite Control San Diego.
- 10. Owner/agent/tenant acknowledges and agrees that inspection of the premises will not include any type of inspection for the presence or non-presence of asbestos and that this report will not include any findings or opinions regarding the presence or non-presence of asbestos in. upon or about the premises, we recommend that you contact a contractor specifically licensed to engage in asbestos related work.
- 11. Furthermore, should we discover the presence of asbestos during our inspection of the premises or should our inspection of the premises causes the release of asbestos dust or particles, owner/agent/tenant shall be solely responsible for the clean-up, removal and disposal of the asbestos and the cost thereof.
